The San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) and Synergy Project Management (contractor), will begin utility relocation for the future Moscone Station and Subway Tunnel Portal construction on Fourth Street between Howard to Bryant Streets. Utility Relocation work on Fourth Street will be performed from January 2010 to approximately June 2011.

Here are some facts that you should be aware of:

- Work Area: Fourth Street from Howard Street to Bryant Street(including side streets) and on Clementina Street between Fourth Street and beyond Fifth Street.
- Two traffic lanes on Fourth Street will be maintained at all times during the construction period.
- Parking spaces will be temporarily closed as needed during construction. Please see construction signs for exact location and times.
- Please expect an increase in noise, dust and traffic as a result of construction.
